

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL  
(MANOR PARK) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 3rd day of August 2023 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 7th day of August 2023 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the whole or on parts of Dovercourt Road, Harwich Road, Manor Park Avenue, Manor Park Centre, Manor Park Close, Manor Park Court, Manor Park Drive, Manor Park Place, Manor Park Rise, Manor Park Road, Manor Park Way, Seaton Close, Seaton Crescent, Seaton Place, Seaton Way, Slingsby Place, Stock Road and Warley Road.

A copy of the Order may be examined during normal opening hours at First Point Reception, Howden House, 1 Union Street, Sheffield, S1 2SH or within the **Sealed Traffic Orders** section on the Council website at <https://www.sheffield.gov.uk/home/roads-pavements/traffic-orders>

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2023 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

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The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 having given public notice in accordance with subsection (2) of that section and schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when use in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 2023, and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Manor Park) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023.
