

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL
(DEERLANDS) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 3rd day of August 2023 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 7th day of August 2023 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the whole or on parts of Colley Avenue, Colley Crescent, Colley Drive, Deerlands Close, High Greave Avenue, High Greave Court, Hillside Avenue, Holgate Avenue, Holgate Crescent, Holgate Drive, Holgate Road, Knowle Road, Margetson Road, Martin Crescent, Milnrow Crescent, Milnrow Drive, Milnrow Road, Milnrow View, Orchard Close, Orchard Crescent, Rokeby Drive, Rokeby Road, St Margaret's Road, St Michael's Close, St Michael's Crescent, Strawberry Avenue, Tunwell Avenue, Tunwell Drive, Tunwell Greave, Turie Avenue, Turie Crescent, Wheata Drive, Wheata Place and Wheata Road.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 3rd August 2023 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 having given public notice in accordance with subsection (2) of that section and schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when use in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of August 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Deerlands) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023.
