I wish to object to site S2S03 in the local plan, specifically the allocation of a industrial site and traveller site at the North end of the site.

My issue is based around the traffic in the area around Eckington Way and surrounding estates including along Sothall Green and Robin lane. Further development will make congestion worse for residents and visitors to the nearby retail sites.

Traffic is a known problem recognised by the council and further development in this area should not go ahead until this matter is resolved.
