Example The Strategy in Summary

A city that's easier to get around - Example, As a clean air Zone is to be implemented it will be more difficult to get around. Movement is already impeded by the large number of Traffic crossing on the ring Road. Planned housing and extra crossings will make this problem worse.

- Faster, better integrated and simpler bus services. Example, Our transport service has deteriorated immensely sine the Covid Lockdown. Many routes have been cancelled completely or partly. Times of intervals between transport arriving has

increased. In some places there is no service at all. In other area bus service end around 5.30pm

- Securing the future of Supertram and supporting its expansion

.Example Super tram service have been cut. for example the purple rout runs hourly it used to be 15 -20 minutes. The original proposals to extend the service were never implemented

- New mass transit routes and services creating more public transport capacity for a growing city.-- Example, There is no guarantee these will happen as there is little co-operation between the 4 councils and the SY Mayoral authority ! The Airport at Doncaster has been closed ! Current media coverage of HS2 appears to indicate that this will be cancelled!

- An inner ring road that has more capacity and is easier to cross into the city centre. When the clean air zone is implemented capacity may increase . This will however mean more small businesses will close.
