I agree with designation of Bolehill Woods as a Local Green Space because this area needs the greatest protection possible.

As an area of ancient native woodland it is irreplaceable ecologically, supporting many protected and declining species. Woodland flora include the ancient woodland indicators English Bluebell, Wild Garlic and Yellow Archangel. Protected mammals include the bats Common Pipistrelle and Noctule, as well as Badgers and Hedgehogs. Birds include the declining Song Thrush, Bullfinch, Tawny Owl and Sparrowhawk. In addition to its ecological significance, the site has great historical value. Records of the woodland's presence go back to at least the 1600s, with continuous documentation throughout the subsequent centuries.

Finally, the wood is of great value to the local community. It's accessible location and beautiful scenery means it used regularly for walks, dog-walking and wildlife-watching. This was particularly important during the covid pandemic, where many locals stated that Bolehill Wood was beneficial to their mental health.
