This site, being greenfield agricultural land ,would better serve the vision, aims and objectives of the plan if it was a split between urban green space zone and university/college zone. The site could be enlarged to include an area of the brownfield land that is in the green belt immediately to the south of site SES28, the entrance to Linleybank, as a university/college zone for a vocational college/ training centre for land skills and environmental technologies. The site could still include housing for people employed on the site and students.

The enlarged site situated as it is adjacent to Linleybank and the Shire Brook Valley nature reserve would present opportunities to address such things as skills shortages, bio-diversity loss, global warming, food security etc.
