NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October 2023 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 2023 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce:-

- Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time on parts of Camm Street, Cobden Place, Cobden View Road, Greenhow Street, Hands Road, Heavygate Avenue, Highton Street, Leamington Street, Matlock Road, Melbourn Road, Mona Avenue, Pickmere Road, Romsdal Road, Sackville Road, Slinn Street, Springvale Road, Townend Street, Warwick Terrace and Western Road.
- Prohibition of Waiting Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm on parts of Western Road.
- Permit holders only bay on parts of Crookesmoor Road
- Prohibition of Driving except Authorised Vehicles and Permit Holders (School Streets) Monday to Friday 8.15-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm at Westways Primary School – Hands Road (between Leamington Road and Warwick Terrace , Leamington Street (between the junctions of Spring House Road and Hands Road), Mona Avenue (the whole), Mona Road (South of Springvale Road). Warwick Street (the whole) and Warwick Terrace (the whole).
- Prohibition of Driving on parts of Cobden View Road, Fir Street, Hands Road, Highton Street, Matlock Road (eastern end), Matlock Road (western end), Newent Lane, Pickmere Road, Sackville Road, Slinn Street and Western Road.
- One Way Streets on parts of Greenhow Street, Heavygate Avenue, Mona Avenue, Mona Road and Springvale Road.

And remove:

- Permit holders only bay on parts of Crookesmoor Road.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling

Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124 (1) (c) (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking And Prohibition Of Waiting) (Outer Area) Order 2008 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-

- a) In Schedule 1.01C thereto for the items ' 288C Cobden View Road – the north east side (i), '449 Greenhow Street - both sides (i)', '467A Hands Road – the south side (ii) and the north side (ii)', '626. Melbourn Road – the south west side (i) and the north east side (i)', ' 638AA Mona Avenue – the south east side (i)' and '850A Springvale Road – the south east/south side (i), the north west/north side (i) and the south side (i)' there were substituted the following items:-

288C.	Cobden View Road	The north east side:  (i) From a point 10 metres north west of its junction with the northern kerb line of Springvale Road to a point 18 metres south east of its junction with the southern kerb line of Springvale Road.
449.	Greenhow Street	Both sides:  (i) from its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Heavygate Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north easterly direction
467A.	Hands Road	The south side:  (ii) From a point 13 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Leamington Street to a point 8 metres south west of its junction with the western kerb line of Leamington Street. (i) From its junction with the south western kerb line of Mona Road for a distance of 11 metres in a south westerly direction.

850A.            Springvale Road                        The south east/ south side:  
(i) From a point 10 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Western Road to a point 20 metres west of its junction with the south western kerb line of Western Road.

The north west/ north side:

(i) From a point 22 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Western Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with the south western kerb line of Western Road.

The south side:

(i) From a point 10 metres east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Cobden View Road to a point 13 metres west of its junction with the south western kerb line of Cobden View Road.

b) In Schedule 1.01H thereto for the items '1339A. Camm Street – both sides (i)', '1409. Greenhow Street - the south east side (iii)', '1429. Heavygate Avenue – the south west side (i) and (ii)' and '1437 Highton Street – the north west side (ii)' there were substituted the following items:-

- (i) From its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Hands Road for a distance of 13 metres in a southerly direction.

The east side:

- (i) From its junction with the southern kerb line of Hands Road for a distance of 8 metres in a southerly direction.

626B. Melbourn Road

The south west side:

- (ii) From its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Slinn Street for a distance of 6 metres in a south easterly direction.

The north east side:

- (ii) From its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Slinn Street for a distance of 6 metres in a south easterly direction.

The north east side:

- (i) From its junction with the northern kerb line of Hands Road for a distance of 13 metres in a north westerly direction.

The south west side:

- (i) From its junction with the north western kerb line of Hands Road for a distance of 8 metres in a north westerly direction.

The east side:

- (i) From its junction with the southern kerb line of Hands Road for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.

- (i) From a point 10 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Melbourn Road to a point 7 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Melbourn Road.

- (ii) From its junction with the south western kerb line of Heavygate Road for a distance of 14 metres in a south westerly direction.

1281AA. Western Road

The north east side:

- (ii) From a point 20 metres north west of its junction with the north western kerb line of Springvale Road to a point 15 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Springvale Road.

The south west side:

- (i) From a point 15 metres north west of its junction with the northern kerb line of Springvale Road to a point 20 metres south east of its junction with the southern kerb line of Springvale Road.

g) In Schedule 2.48 thereto for the item 'Western Road' there was included the following item:-

- (ii) From a point 50 metres north west of its junction with the north western kerb line of Mona Avenue for a distance of 23 metres in a north westerly direction.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Crookes Active Neighbourhood) (Prohibition Of Driving And One Way Traffic) Order 2023.
2. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in those parts of roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 within the length of road described in Column 2 of that Schedule to this Order.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order other than in the direction specified in Column 2 of that Schedule.

Exemptions

4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle which is:-
  - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes in an emergency;  
or
  - b) proceeding upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124 (1) (c) (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Various Roads, Crookes Sheffield) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2023.

PART 1

2. Definitions

In this Order:-

"Access Permit" means a permit issued by the Council, which may be virtual or physical, and used in the manner directed by the Council.

"Authorised Vehicle" means;

- (a) A Private Hire Vehicle booked in advance for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers to or from premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road; or
- (b) A Taxi for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers to or from premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road; or
- (c) A Contractual Vehicle; or
- (d) a Disabled Persons Vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge requiring access to a property on a Restricted Road;

"Bus" has the same meaning as Public Service Vehicle as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Contractual Vehicle" means a Bus, Private Hire Vehicle or Taxi, contracted by the Council and/or school, to take children to or from a school which is fronting or adjacent to the Restricted Roads;

"Council" means Sheffield City Council;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (SI 2000 No.682 as amended by SI 2000 No. 1507 and SI 2007 No.2531);

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

"Goods" includes merchandise and postal packets of any description and "delivering" or "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"Healthcare Worker" means

- (a) Any such persons currently identified by an NHS Trust (or any other name that it may subsequently be known) as being a general practitioner, doctor, registered nurse or any other nominated medical persons undertaking domiciliary visits to patients residing within premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road; or

- (b) Any such persons as are authorised by the Council to be essential healthcare or family support visitors to patients residing within premises accessible by vehicle only from Restricted Road;

“Motor Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“Private Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Relevant Position” means with respect to an Access Permit which is physical or a Disabled Person’s Badge and where either is displayed on a vehicle where –

- (a) they are exhibited on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle, or  
(b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia, they are exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle,

so that the front of the Access Permit or Disabled Person’s Badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle;

“Resident” means a person whose usual place of residence is at the postal address of which is situated in any parts of the roads identified as a Restricted Road on the plans to this Order;

“Restricted Road” means any Road or part of Road specified in Schedule 1 to therein access is restricted to time, place, day in accordance with the provisions of this Order;

“Road” has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

“Schools” means a school situated on the length of a Restricted Road;

“Taxi” is a vehicle licensed as a hackney carriage under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 as amended;

“Term Time” means the part of the year during which the Schools are open for holding classes.

## PART 2

### 3. Prohibition of Driving

- (1) Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 no person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in those parts of Roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 within the length of Road described in Column 2 of that Schedule and the times specified in Column 3 to this Order, during term time and excluding Bank Holidays.

### 4. The provisions of Article 3 do not apply to any vehicle:

- (a) displaying a valid Permit in the Relevant Position and that Permit is so displayed for the whole time that the vehicle remains in the Restricted Road;  
or  
(b) has a valid Virtual Permit; or  
(c) being an Authorised Vehicle.

PART 3

5. General Exemptions

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance on an emergency;
- b) proceeding upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform;
- c) in the service of the Council being necessarily used in connection with highway maintenance, parking enforcement, waste collection or street cleansing activities in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
- d) being used, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, in the service of a local authority or of a statutory undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- e) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely –
  - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
  - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road; and
  - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, line or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any line which is, or forms part of electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;
- f) a vehicle in the service of a universal service provider as defined in section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2011 being used for delivering or collecting postal packets from premises that can only be accessed via a Restricted Road;
- g) for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting Goods or loading or unloading a vehicle at premises that can only be accessed via a Restricted Road and evidence is provided to the satisfaction of the Council;
- h) to access any premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road so long as access by these vehicles is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
- i) being used to access a property on a Restricted Road if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road by a Healthcare Worker whilst undertaking healthcare worker duties where evidence is provided to show reason.

(MONA ROAD, CROOKES, SHEFFIELD)  
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2023

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124 (1) (c) (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of October, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Mona Road, Crookes, Sheffield)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2023.

PART 1

2. Definitions

In this Order:-

"Access Permit" means a permit issued by the Council, which may be virtual or physical, and used in the manner directed by the Council.

"Authorised Vehicle" means;

- (e) A Private Hire Vehicle booked in advance for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers to or from premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road; or
- (f) A Taxi for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers to or from premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road; or
- (g) A Contractual Vehicle; or
- (d) A Disabled Persons Vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge requiring access to a property on a Restricted Road;

"Bus" has the same meaning as Public Service Vehicle as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Contractual Vehicle" means a Bus, Private Hire Vehicle or Taxi, contracted by the Council and/or school, to take children to or from a school which is fronting or adjacent to the Restricted Roads;

"Council" means Sheffield City Council;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (SI 2000 No.682 as amended by SI 2000 No. 1507 and SI 2007 No.2531);

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

"Goods" includes merchandise and postal packets of any description and "delivering" or "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"Healthcare Worker" means

- (c) Any such persons currently identified by an NHS Trust (or any other name that it may subsequently be known) as being a general practitioner, doctor, registered nurse or any other nominated medical persons undertaking domiciliary visits to patients residing within premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road; or
- (b) Any such persons as are authorised by the Council to be essential healthcare or family support visitors to patients residing within premises accessible by vehicle only from Restricted Road;

"Motor Vehicle" has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“Private Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Relevant Position” means with respect to an Access Permit which is physical or a Disabled Person’s Badge and where either is displayed on a vehicle where –

- (a) they are exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or
- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, they are exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, so that the front of the Access Permit or Disabled Person’s Badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle;

“Resident” means a person whose usual place of residence is at the postal address of which is situated in any parts of the roads identified as a Restricted Road on the plans to this Order;

“Restricted Road” means any Road or part of Road specified in Schedule 1 to therein access is restricted to time, place, day in accordance with the provisions of this Order;

“Road” has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

“Schools” means a school situated on the length of a Restricted Road;

“Taxi” is a vehicle licensed as a hackney carriage under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 as amended;

“Term Time” means the part of the year during which the Schools are open for holding classes.

## PART 2

### 3. Prohibition of Driving

(1) Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 no person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in those parts of Roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 within the length of Road described in Column 2 of that Schedule and the times specified in Column 3 to this Order, during term time and excluding Bank Holidays.

4. The provisions of Article 3 do not apply to any vehicle:

- (a) displaying a valid Permit in the Relevant Position and that Permit is so displayed for the whole time that the vehicle remains in the Restricted Road; or
- (b) has a valid Virtual Permit; or
- (c) being an Authorised Vehicle.

## PART 3

### 5. General Exemptions

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance on an emergency;
- (b) proceeding upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform;
- (c) in the service of the Council being necessarily used in connection with highway maintenance, parking enforcement, waste collection or street cleansing activities in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
- (d) being used, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, in the service of a local authority or of a statutory undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely –
  - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
  - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road; and

- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, line or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any line which is, or forms part of electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;
- (f) a vehicle in the service of a universal service provider as defined in section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2011 being used for delivering or collecting postal packets from premises that can only be assessed via a Restricted Road;
- (g) for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting Goods or loading or unloading a vehicle at premises that can only be assessed via a Restricted Road and evidence is provided to the satisfaction of the Council;
- (h) to access any premises accessible by vehicle only from a Restricted Road so long as access by these vehicles is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
- (i) being used to access a property on a Restricted Road if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road by a Healthcare Worker whilst undertaking healthcare worker duties where evidence is provided to show reason.
