

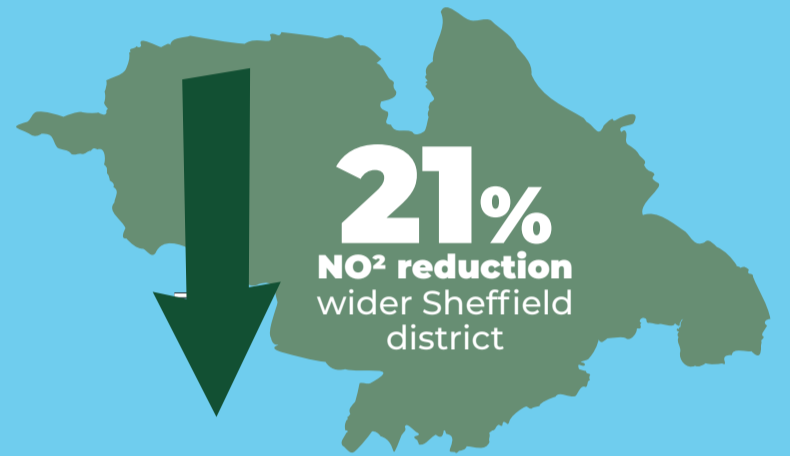
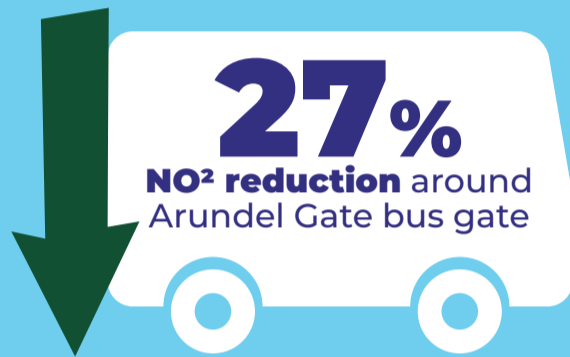
# Sheffield City Council Nitrogen dioxide annual average data 2023

**Air quality in Sheffield is improving**



Overall, since the launch of the Clean Air Zone (CAZ), there has been:



## Vehicle compliance

Our vehicle monitoring surveys showed that, **between November 2022 and October 2023 the number of non-compliant vehicles in the CAZ reduced by**

**64%**

**37%** of vehicle journeys were **non-compliant**
