- Bus Gates At all times on parts of Arundel Gate and Furnival Gate;
- · Prescribed right-hand turn on St. Pauls Place Service Road;
- Prohibited right-hand turn on part of Arundel Gate;

### And remove:

• Prescribed left turn on part of Town Hall/Novotel Car Park Egress.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (as amended) shall have effect as though:
  - a) In Bus Gates, Exemptions, thereto there was included the following item:-
    - Nothing in Article 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any vehicle to enter or proceed in a north easterly direction on Arundel Gate if that vehicle is over 5.5 m long and is loading or unloading at premises;
      - (i) No. 37-43 Arundel Gate
      - (ii) No. 48 Arundel Gate and
      - (iii) on the unnamed service area to the rear of The Central Library.
  - d) In Schedule 3 Bus Gates At All Times thereto there were included the following items:-
    - 1AA. Arundel Gate

That area of the north east bound carriageway of Arundel Gate from a point 30 metres north east of its junction with the south western kerb line of St. Paul's Place Service Road for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction which is bounded:-

- a) on the north west side by the north western kerb line thereof:
- b) on the south east side by the kerb line of the traffic island.
- Furnival Gate

That area of the south east bound carriageway of Furnival Gate from a point 2.5 metres south east of its junction with the north western kerb line of Pinstone Street for a distance of 10 metres in a south easterly direction which is bounded:-

- a) on the north east side by the north eastern kerb line thereof:
- b) on the south west side by the kerb line of the traffic island.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2024 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (amendment no.80) Order 2024.
