NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Sheffield City Council proposes to make an Order under the provisions of Section 84 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce:

- 30mph Speed Limit on parts of Lodge Lane;
- 30mph (Restricted Road Speed Limit) on parts of Redmires Road;

And remove:

- 40mph Speed Limit on parts of Redmires Road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Redmires Road

The proposed change to the existing 40mph speed limit and the introduction of the Restricted Road 30mph Speed Limit is required to control vehicles speeds at a more appropriate level for the different sections of Redmires Road.

Lodge Lane

The proposed extension of the 30mph speed limit is required to control vehicle speeds on Lodge Lane on its approach to its junction with The Fairway.
