## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

## THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY (YORKSHIRE AND THE HUMBER) (NO.9) ORDER 2022

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

1. The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the plan numbered NATTRAN/Y&H/S247/4828, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by Sheffield City Council, under reference 21/02236/FUL.

2. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.

3. This Order shall come into force on 28 April 2022



## THE SCHEDULE

## Description of highway to be stopped up

The highway to be stopped up is at Sheffield in the City of Sheffield, shown on the plan as an irregular shaped southern part width of Abbeydale Road. It commences from the north eastern corner of no.89 Abbeydale Road extending in a south westerly direction for a distance of 3.7 metres and having a maximum width of 2 metres.
