



Census 2021: Armed Forces Topic Summary

The source of all the data presented is the 2021 Census.

Key points

- At the time of the 2021 Census, there were 13,093 armed forces veterans living in Sheffield.
- At 2.9%, the proportion of armed forces veterans in Sheffield is lower than both the Yorkshire and Humber (4.2%) and England (3.8%) average.
- There is a person who has served in the armed forces in 5.4% of Sheffield households. This is also lower than the Yorkshire and Humber (7.5%) and England (7.0%) averages.
- Stocksbridge is the ward with the highest proportion of residents who are armed forces veterans (4.1%), while City is the lowest (0.8%)

The structure of armed forces veteran population

The veteran population differs in structure to the non-veteran population. They are older and they also differ in relation to sex and where they live, and these factors interact with other personal characteristics. For example, age can be strongly related to legal partnership status, health and religion. Because of this, veterans may differ to the non-veteran population when considering these characteristics. It is important to be aware of these differences but also to understand when these differences are not attributable to the status of having previously served in the UK armed forces and can be explained by the unique structure of the veteran population.

Comparisons involving previously served populations should also consider that during and after the Second World War there was National Service in the UK. This means that the population of those previously serving in the UK armed forces is highly skewed to males in older age groups.
