NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Sheffield City Council proposes to make an Order under the provisions of Section 84 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce 20mph Speed Limit on the whole or parts of Attercliffe Road, Baker Street, Baldwin Street, Baltic Lane, Baltic Road, Baltic Way, Beverley Street, Bodmin Street, Bootle Street, Brinsworth Street, Britnall Street, Burgess Road, Chapel Lane, Chippingham Place, Chippingham Street, Church Lane, Colwall Street, Ferguson Street, Heppenstall Lane, Kimberley Street, Lawrence Street, Leeds Road, Oakes Green, Otter Street, Shirland Close, Shirland Lane, Shortridge Street, Staniforth Road, St Charles Street, Titterton Close, Titterton Street, Worksop Road, Zion Lane
