NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 6th day of February 2025 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 10th day of February 2025 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce:

Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Places on parts of Balmoral Road, Bishopsholme Road, Flodden Street, Freedom Road (Walkley) Car Park, Hope Street (Stocksbridge) Car Park, Louth Road, Slate Street, Station Road (Darnall) Car Park and Upwood Road.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124 (1) (c) (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Various Roads and Off-Street Car Parks) (Electric Vehicle Parking Places) Order 2021 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-
