- No waiting Monday to Friday 08.30 to 09.15 and 15.00 to 15.45 on part of Jenkin Avenue
- No waiting Monday to Friday 08.00 to 09.30 and 16.30 to 18.30 on part of Rutland Road
- No waiting at any time on footway/verge on part of Meadow Head
- No loading Monday to Saturday 08.00 to 18.30 on parts of Rockingham Close and Rockingham Gate
- No loading Monday to Friday 0800 to 09.30 and 16.00 to 18.30 on parts of Handsworth Road
- No loading Monday to Friday 0800 to 09.30 and 16.30 to 18.30 on parts of Rutland Road

### STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Authority's reasons for proposing to make the above-named Order(s) are as follows: -

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

### Explanatory Notes: -

Beet Street, Brook Lane, Butts Hill, Canning Street, Castlefolds, Collinson Road, Division Lane, Division Street, Dover Street, Ellison Street, Fawcett Street, Gatefield Road, Glover Street, Haden Street, Hammond Street, Handsworth Road, Hillfoot Road, Hoyle Street, Hyacinth Close, Jenkin Avenue, Jenkin Drive, Jenkin Road, King Street Unnamed Service Road, Meadow Head, Middle Ox Gardens, Mulberry Street, Naseby Street, Netherthorpe Place, Rockingham Close, Rockingham Gate, Rockingham Lane, Rockingham Street, Rutland Road, Shalesmoor, St Mary's Road, Upper Allen Street, Upperthorpe Road, Westfield Terrace and Winter Street.

The proposed changes to the waiting restrictions formalise the current restrictions on street. An audit of our new map based system has revealed some anomalies that require us to formally advertise restrictions in order to make them legally enforceable or to delete them from our legal record. The restrictions are either already in place on street or do not exist on street.
